37	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: None
38	MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING: The Minutes of the meeting held on 21st May 2012 were approved as a correct record.
39 39.1  39.2	<p>PLANNING MATTERS:</p> <p><i>Applications for consideration:</i></p> <p><u>39.1.1 Manor Farm, Rakes Road:</u> Listed Building Consent – The proposal is for the sympathetic restoration and conversion of The Shippon, Manor Farmhouse dating from the 1860s, to create a single dwelling. The Parish Council is in favour of this application yet would like to see the proposed conversion to remain as part of the main house and unable to be sold separately. We also feel that the roof would be more aesthetically pleasing if in keeping with the main house.</p> <p><i>Planning Authority decisions for notification:</i> None received. It was noted that the Clerk has not been notified of a recent decision yet the applicant has. This is the planning application for the field next to Hawthorne House, Chapel Street, for Mr P Woolley. The Clerk was instructed to ask PDNPA the reason for this omission.</p>

41	RENOVATION OF SCHOOL PLAYING FIELD: Cllr Mrs Scoggins has completed and sent an Access Statement as part of the application. The Council will be notified mid July whether the application has been successful.
42	WAR MEMORIAL: Approval was given for Mr Mark Eaton to clean the war memorial at a cost of £890. The work will be carried out on 26 <sup>th</sup> June. Cllr Mrs Frost will ask his advice on how often the war memorial is likely to require cleaning, for budgeting purposes.
43	VILLAGE GREEN: A letter has been sent to a local resident asking not to park on the grass on the Village Green. Matter completed.
44	SPEEDING IN THE VILLAGE: The Clerk has made enquiries to DCC with regard to the cost of vehicle activated speed signs. The Clerk had also requested Highways Officers visit to re-assess and advise on improvements to road safety in the village.
45	JUNCTION AT THE END OF HORSE LANE: The Clerk has made enquiries to DCC

	with regard to the white line painting. Awaiting response.
46	CHEVRON ROAD SIGNS ON RAKES ROAD. The Clerk has reported the graffiti on these to DCC.
47	WEIGHT LIMIT – RAKES ROAD: Cllr Mark Leach has contacted DCC for information on weight restrictions for PSV's on this road as these vehicles have been seen using it. A reply from DCC is awaited.
48	PARISH COUNCIL VACANCY: Cllr Mark Leach formally resigned from the Parish Council. Cllr Mrs Jean Frost thanked Cllr Leach for his invaluable input and dedication to the council over recent years and expressed that he will be greatly missed. Cllr Leach's resignation creates a vacancy within the Council. A notice to this effect will be placed on the village notice board advising interested residents to contact the Elections Officer at DDDC by 6 <sup>th</sup> July. An election will only take place if 10 residents apply to DDDC.
