110	RENOVATION OF SCHOOL PLAYING FIELD: Mrs Wales and Cllr Mrs Scoggins met with Mrs Les Warren from DDDC at the school field on 19 November to discuss an application for their Play Development Fund. Mr Warren advised Mrs Wales and Mrs Scoggins that the Play Development Fund is usually awarded to projects requiring play equipment and that the National Lottery Awards for All may be a more appropriate grant to apply for. Mrs Wales has all the application form and will complete this and send as soon as possible. The Parish Council is awaiting payment of the Aggregates Levy grant. The walling work is due to commence in January.
