47	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: None
48	MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING: The Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 3 rd July 2013 were approved as a correct record following the amendment at Minute number 45 to read six parking spaces and not four.
49	PLANNING MATTERS:
49.1	<i>Applications for consideration:</i> None received.
49.2	<i>Planning Authority decisions for notification:</i> <u>49.2.1 Chapel Street, Monyash:</u> Proposed erection of local need affordable house, for Mr Woolley and Ms Critchlow. PDNPA decision : Granted <u>49.2.2 8 The Square, Church Street:</u> Proposed alterations and extensions to existing building including new vehicular access and new off street parking area, for Mr Margret Mitchell. PDNPA decision : Granted The above decisions were noted by the Parish Council
49.3	<i>Geoplan Community Involvement: Once a Week Quarry:</i> The Parish Council has received correspondence from Geoplan to advise of a forthcoming planning application that is to be submitted by them to the PDNPA for this site. The plans enclosed essentially comprise a small extension to existing quarry workings. This is necessary because permitted reserves at the site are now virtually exhausted. The letter received is not part of a formal consultation process, it's purpose is to update local people. The Parish Council has no objection to the proposed plans and welcomes the opportunity for continued employment in local industry. The Clerk was instructed to write to Geoplan to inform them of this.

51	RENOVATION OF SCHOOL PLAYING FIELD: Mr Jonathan Hutchinson has been unable to commence the fencing work around the school field due to other work commitments. Therefore the Parish Council decided that Pugh-Lewis, the draining contractors should be asked to commence the drainage work as the Aggregates Levy Grant awarded to fund this has to be spent by

	November this year. The Parish Council has until May 2014 to spend the Grant from the Big Lottery Fund, and it is envisaged that Mr Hutchinson will be able to carry out the fencing work after the drainage work is complete in plenty of time before next May.
52	FERE MERE WEED PROBLEM: Cllr Mrs Scoggins has this matter in hand. Deferred until the next meeting.
53	PARKING ON FROST MERE: Matter complete.
54	PALFREYMAN TRUST: Cllr Mrs Jean Frost brought to the Council's attention that the Palfreyman Trust has invited a Member to stand as Parish Council Representative on the Trust. Cllr Mrs Jean Frost explained the role and what is entailed. Members agreed to consider this and inform the Clerk.
55	DIST. CLLR DAVID FREDERICKSON: Cllr Frederickson brought to the Council's attention the procedure of Community Right to Bid, which is the process of listing a Building that is of important local value. More information on this can be obtained on the DDDC website under the Community Section.
