135	TRAINING ON NEW STANDING ORDERS AND ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE: The Clerk attended a course on 9 February. All Standing Orders are circulated by DALC. The Clerk and all Members agreed to keep up to date with these. The Clerk will book onto a CiLCA (Certificate in Local Council Administration) course which will give training on accounting procedure.
136	FERE MERE WEED PROBLEM: Cllr Mrs Joanna Scoggins has met a Conservation Officer from the PDNPA on site. The PDNPA is to monitor how the weed is growing for one year then review. The Clerk has written to Disley and New Mills Angling Club and will liaise with them further for advice.
137	RENOVATION OF SCHOOL PLAYING FIELD: The Clerk has written to Mr Mike Harris and is awaiting a response. Prior to this Cllr Macdonald has been informed by Mr Harris that all Defra grants are now in the hands of the government and awaiting notification from them. The Clerk was instructed to start make enquiries to Defra with regard to

	the status of existing grant application and also explore other funding sources, eg National Lottery Grants.
138	PROPOSED VILLAGE TOILET CLOSURE: No further update has been given to the Council.
139	MONYASH VILLAGE MARKET DAY: The Clerk will write to Mrs Edwards, Secretary of the Market Committee requesting a list of stall-holders which will be attending on Market Day. The Clerk will also book Ashbourne Band for the event.
140	VILLAGE GREEN: With regard to the ongoing problem of damage to the Village Green, Cllr Macdonald will arrange for a sign to be made asking motorists not to park on the grass.
141	DRAINS OPPOSITE MANOR HOUSE FARM, RAKES ROAD: It has been noted that the drains appear to be becoming blocked with the build up of mud where the road bends. The Clerk was instructed to contact DCC to report the problem.
