34	DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: None
35	MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING: The Minutes of the meeting held on 17 <sup>th</sup> May 2011 were approved as a correct record.
36	ISABEL FRENZEL, RURAL HOUSING ENABLER: Isabel Frenzel presented her report from the recent housing needs survey. As a result of the survey 16 households in the village have been identified as having affordable housing need. From this the building of 5 new houses have been proposed. Members discussed with Isabel the possible location for these. Isabel will liaise with the PDNPA with regard to this and keep the Parish Council informed.

The Clerk was also instructed to write to Mrs Edwards, Secretary of the Market Committee to enquire what money was raised from the stalls. The possibility of having a marquee on the village green for future Village Market days was suggested.
