It was generally felt that whilst this is a fantastically worthwhile project which will benefit the village, the implementation must be sensitively handled, to allow residents to be kept informed and ensure that potential hurdles are not missed.</p> <p>Whilst the Parish Council is completely in support of the initiative, it was felt that it is not the forum for actual implementation of the scheme.</p> <p>The fundraising is going well, with the start of the envelope scheme and offers of support from the organisers of the White Peak Walk for.</p> <p>Cllr Bamforth will produce an information leaflet to be available at the village market, to supplement the collection of envelopes to raise funds.
