106	<p>Clerk's report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cllr. G Elliot reported that the Youlgrave recycling centre now closed. An enhanced doorstep service will now be provided to village residents. Details of this will be sent to every resident who receives the County Council magazine (Dales Matters), or can be obtained from the website. • Highways dept. to be contacted regarding re-setting kerb stones on parking area near mere. Action JB - ongoing • Cllr G Elliot has once again kindly offered a grant to help the village. Suggestions to be discussed at the April meeting. • It was agreed that a plaque would not be put up next to the defibrillator, as so many people had given generously, it would not be appropriate to single out a few. • It was agreed that a letter be sent to the landowner of fields adjacent to Naylor Lane requesting the stone from broken dry stone walls be removed, as it is causing an obstruction. Action AJ • The PC has received five complaints from residents about roads and pavements being covered in manure from a muck spreader. Whilst it is accepted that this is inevitable to a certain degree in a village at the heart of farming country, it was felt that this incident was above that level, and could cause a slip hazard to pedestrians, and worse for cyclists. – Formal complaint to farm, highways and landowner - Action JS
